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Critical Acclaim: 2010 Syrah

Sourced from the Les Collines (52%), Seven Hills (35%) and Pepper Bridge (13%) vineyards, this Syrah displays a deep purplish ruby color and seductive aromas of wild blackberries, blueberries, pomegranates, lavender and violets. The flavors are well saturated, bursting with vibrant young fruits, intermixed with black licorice, dark chocolate, French roast and silty earth minerals. The back reveals notes of roasted berries and soy marinated nuts, crème de cassis and nougat, followed by a squeeze of blueberry juice on a sweet-dry tannin finish that shows enough presence to suggest aging 2-3 or more years. Delivers a lot for the price.
